Quinte Health Care is seeking a Lead Intensivist and Staff Intensivist for a closed management model adult Critical Care Unit to be launched in the fall of 2010. This service will provide coverage for a newly constructed level III intensive care unit located at QHC Belleville General. The program will be supported by an experienced critical care team including nursing, 24/7 RT coverage, PT, OT, speech therapy, nutritionist and pharmacist.

MEDICAL DIRECTOR INTENSIVE CARE UNIT **Rockyview General Hospital**

The University of Calgary and Alberta Health Service's Department of Critical Care Medicine invites applications for a clinical/administrative position at the Clinical Associate Professor or higher level to provide leadership to the ICU of the Rockyview General Hospital. The successful candidate will have specialty certification in Critical Care Medicine, several years experience in the care of critically ill patients and demonstrated leadership skills. Duties with this position

include coordination and organization of service delivery within a multidisciplinary environment, establishment of Quality Improvement initiatives pertaining to care delivery processes within the ICU and Calgary Zone critical care community, participation in educational activities within the Department of Critical Care Medicine and collaboration in integrated Departmental research programs. Rockyview General Hospital has 10 ICU beds and had >450 admissions in 2009. Of those admissions, approximately 73% are medical patients and 25% surgical patients. Ideally, the suitable candidate would commence this role on September 1, 2010.

The Faculty of Medicine has recently built a major new research facility. Calgary is a vibrant, multicultural city (population of 1,200,000) near the Rocky Mountains, Banff National Park and Lake Louise.
