OPPORTUNITIES AT QHC

Quinte Health Care is seeking a Lead Intensivist and Staff Intensivist for a closed management model adult Critical Care Unit to be launched in the fall of 2010. This service will provide coverage for a newly constructed level III intensive care unit located at QHC Belleville General. The program will be supported by an experienced critical care team including nursing, 24/7 RT coverage, PT, OT, speech therapy, nutritionist and pharmacist.

Support will also be provided by consultants in a wide variety of medical and surgical specialties including anesthesia, cardiology, gastroenterology, internal medicine, oncology, general surgery, orthopedics, urology, gynecology and psychiatry. Full imaging modalities are available including MRI, multi-slice CT scanner, ultrasound, nuclear medicine and PACS.
